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**HARI PAL VERMA, J. (Oral)**

Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C, the petitioner has challenged the order dated 23.12.2014 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, whereby, the present petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender.

This Court, vide order dated 29.09.2015, has passed the following order:-

*Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in the complaint filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, the petitioner was never served during the entire proceedings.*

*Notice of motion for 20.11.2015.*

*In the meanwhile, in case the petitioner appears and surrender before the trial Court within a week, the trial*

*Court shall admit the petitioner on bail, however, subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 29.09.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and furnished requisite bail bonds.

Nobody is present on behalf of the respondent, despite service.

In view of the above, the averments made in the petition stands un rebutted.

Accordingly, the order dated 29.09.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court as and when required to do so in accordance with law unless the Court grants exemption from personal appearance.
