Report dated 12.2.2016 of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana has been received after recording statements of accused Sanjeev Gupta and Sachin Mittal as well as complainant Lokesh Sharma and the learned court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is an outcome of voluntariness, free will and without any coercion or undue pressure. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and in view of the fact that compromise will go a long way in resolving the personal dispute and to bring about personal harmony and more-so the offences for which the accused have been booked are not of very serious nature and in view of the law laid down in **Gian Singh vs State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and in view of which the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.

173 dated 15.5.2015 registered at Police Station Jodhewal, Ludhiana under sections 420, 120-B IPC and all consequences arising thereof are quashed, qua the present petitioners.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
