This is the second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.362 dated 7.12.2014, under Sections 376(2)N, (2)F, 354A(i) IPC, and under Sections 6 and 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Bhattu Kalan, District Fatehabad. Prayer has also been made to set aside the order dated 11.9.2015 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Fatehabad, whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed person as the petitioner has failed to appear before the Court despite execution of proclamation warrant under Section 82 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition as the petitioner is ready to surrender before

the trial Court, provided his bail application is ordered to be decided at the earliest.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a week from today, the trial Court shall make an endeavour to decide the application for bail moved by the petitioner within three days from the date of filing the same.
