In view of the fact that the co-accused of the petitioner has been granted the concession of bail, the petitioner can also be granted the same relief on the basis of parity as he is not named in the FIR and has been arrayed as an accused on the basis of supplementary statement of the complainant, recorded after more than 20 days of the occurrence.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
