DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No.196 dated 04.07.2015 under Sections 498-A, 323, 506 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sector 56, Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in the case, whereas, they have no role in any manner. Petitioner no.1 is 75 years of age, whereas, petitioner No.2 is 72 years of age. Both the petitioners are residing in Chandigarh and they never resided with the complainant and her husband, who were residing in Gurgaon. The purpose of filing the FIR, in question, against the petitioners is that the complainant wants to take forcible possession of the flat, situated at Gurgaon.

Admittedly, the investigation has not been completed and the

same is still in progress. It cannot be said at this stage that the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner will not be considered by the Investigating Officer. To interfere in the present petition would amount to interference with the investigation, which is still in progress.

Keeping in view the stage, no ground is made out to quash the FIR at this stage. However, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case, the investigation has not been completed, the documents proving the fact that they have been residing separately and submissions made in the present petition be considered by the Investigating Officer while concluding the investigation.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
