The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.52, dated 6.5.2015, registered under Sections 420, 120-B of the IPC and Section 66 of the Information Technology Act, at Police Station Rajasansi, District Amritsar.

As per allegations, the petitioner had cheated the complainant by making a call that he had won a lottery and persuaded him to deposit some money in his account.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody for 1 year 4 months and 8 days.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab has accepted this factual assertion.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
