By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.79 dated 19.08.2016, registered under Sections 148, 323, 324 and 506 read with Section 149 of IPC, at Police Station Naggal, District Ambala.

On 16.09.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Notice of motion to the respondent-State for 21.10.2016.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail in FIR No.79 dated 19.8.2016, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Naggal, District Ambala, on furnishing of his bail bond amounting to Rs. 10,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting

officer.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 16.09.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation

The learned State counsel, on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 16.09.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
