The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.140, dated 14.7.2016, registered under Sections 419, 420, 120-B, 465, 467, 468, 471, 506 of the IPC, at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana.

As per allegations, the petitioner obtained money from the

complainant by producing an impostor and with the aid of forged

documents.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that as a matter of fact no impostor was presented but the real person was presented and if the signatures on the documents are compared with the admitted signatures, his stand would be borne out.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab has accepted that this would be an appropriate way of throwing some light on this matter and undertakes to get the admitted signatures compared by the FSL.

Counsel for the petitioner has further argued that till such time as the report of the FSL is received, the petitioner should be released on interim bail.

I find this to be a fair request. In the circumstances, the petitioner be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court and the decision on the confirmation/vacation thereof will taken after the receipt of the FSL. This petition stands disposed of.
