Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Krishan @ Papu, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and (Section 326, IPC added later on), in a case arising out of FIR No.41 dated 07.02.2015, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

As per the allegations, the petitioner armed with a *Khurpi* along with four other co-accused/non-applicants armed with various weapons and 4-5 unknown persons had inflicted injuries on the complainant-Hardeep Singh, who was trying to remove the *Rehris* and *Farhis* of all the accused.

The role attributed to the petitioner is of inflicting a injury on the left little finger of the complainant.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Kuldeep Singh, concedes that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 06.10.2015, is made absolute.
