Through instant petition preferred under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, Deepak @ Deepak Kumar-petitioner has sought regular bail, in case FIR No.61, dated 06.05.2011, under Sections 307, 325, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, Police Station City South Moga, District Moga, during the pendency of trial.

2. Undisputably, the petitioner is in custody for the last about 8 months after having been arrested on jumping the bail. A petition for quashing the FIR on the basis of compromise is already pending before this Court on 18.10.2016. Moreover, co-accused of the petitioner namely Gagandeep Singh @ Lambu has already been granted the concession of bail by this Court vide order dated 07.09.2016 passed in CRM-M-29541-2016,

on the ground of parity, present petitioner also deserves the concession of bail.

3. Taking into consideration all the aforesaid aspects of this case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, during pendency of trial, at the satisfaction of trial court/Duty Magistrate.
