Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.124 dated 15.05.2016, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 307, 186, 353, 332, 342, 506, 435, 511, 427, 148, 149 and 379-B IPC and Section 8-B NHAI Act 1956 added lateron.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that all the similarly situated co-accused of the petitioner have been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 24.08.2016 passed in Criminal Misc.No.M-28697 of 2016.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has accepted these factual assertions.

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In these circumstances, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly. Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
