In compliance of the order dated 19.09.2016, petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 03.10.2016 (Annexure P-9) and furnished bail bonds and surety bonds in the sum of Rs.75,000/- and the same was accepted by the trial Court.

The matter was taken up today in the presence of parents of the petitioner, complainant and counsel for the complainant. Learned counsel for the complainant has not disputed the statement made by Kamaljit Kaur-complainant that she has accepted a draft of Rs.13.5 lacs on 02.05.2011 on behalf of her and her daughter and she will not demand any maintenance from the petitioner in future. She further stated in her statement that this amount will be spent for the education and marriage of her daughter. On specific query put by the Court, she submits that she would make the FDR of the total amount in the name of her daughter who is studying in school.

In view of the above and keeping in view the statement made by

the complainant(Annexure P-2), the present petition is disposed of and the bail order dated 03.10.2016 (Annexure P-9) is made absolute and petitioner will be bound to the terms of the provisions as envisaged under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
