Petitioner along with others was arrested on 20.06.2016 on the basis of a secret information. The petitioner along with his accomplice was allegedly travelling in Qualis and had fired in the air. Co-accused of the petitioner, similarly circumstanced, has been granted the concession of bail. The recoveries have already been effected. On the principle of parity, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Learned State counsel opposes the application contending that petitioner is involved in two other criminal cases. As per learned counsel for the petitioner he has been granted the concession of bail. In view of above said circumstances, petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
