JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Jaspreet Singh in case FIR No.40 dated 16.05.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 452, 506, 324, 148, 149 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that only a wooden stick blow on the finger of the left hand has been attributed to the petitioner. He further submits that in fact, petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. There was no occasion for the petitioner to involve in the incident alleged against him.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner further submits that pursuant

to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation. He further submits that petitioner is a young student and other co-accused have been arrested and recovery has been effected.

Learned State counsel assisted by HC Baldev Singh does not refute the contention that the other co-accused have been arrested and the petitioner has joined investigation and recovery is effected and that he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 17th of September, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
