By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioners have sought pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 10 dated 21.01.2014 under Sections 307, 323, 336, 148, 149 IPC and under Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab whereas, Mr. Karamjit Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2. Copies of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel as well to the counsel of respondent No.2, during the course of day.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioners is that after registration of above-said FIR, a compromise (Annexure P-2) was arrived at in between the parties and a petition bearing *CRM No. M-6369 of*

2016 under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR in question on the basis of compromise was moved but during the pendency of instant petition, petitioners were declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 30.10.2015.

In view of the changed circumstances the petition i.e. CRM No.M-6369 of 2016 seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise was withdrawn.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to petitioners to appear/surrender before the trial Court within a period of 7 days from the date of certified copy of this order and move an application for bail, which shall be dealt with and disposed of by learned trial Court within a period of 7 days from the date of its presentation.
