INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.25 dated 13.06.2016, registered at Police Station Qila Lal Singh, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 323, 324, 326 and 34 IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has been named in FIR. He was stated to be armed with deadly weapon i.e. *datar* and specific injury has been attributed to him on the right wrist of the complainant which has been declared grievous one. The present petitioner is the main accused. The weapon i.e. *datar* is yet to be recovered, therefore, his custodial interrogation is required.

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Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and nature and gravity of the offence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
