The petitioner who is a lady, has remained in detention close to six months uptill now. The recovery imputed to her is in respect of contraband is marginally in excess of the commercial quantity. It transpires that three out of a total of seven cited witnesses have been examined in the trial Court and now the next date is fixed on the 11th of November. No private witness was at all cited in the challan. There is no history of any previous involvement of the petitioner under the NDPS Act.

In the given circumstances she may be released on bail on such terms and conditions as may be deemed appropriate by the trial Court.
