The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.71 dated 23.11.2015 for the offence under Sections 306, 34 IPC (Section 304-B, 498-A IPC added lateron) registered at Police Station Mehal Kanal, District Barnala.

The deceased-Paramjit Kaur had committed suicide and after registration of the FIR, under Section 306, 34 IPC, Sections 304 B and 408A/34 IPC were added later on after framing of charges. Out of 18 witnesses, only examination-in-chief of the complainant has been recorded and an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. has been filed for additional evidence which has been dismissed on 27.10.2016.

Keeping in view the above and the fact that trial is going on for almost one year which is not likely to conclude in near future,

petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing his fresh bail

bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate,
Barnala.
