Having absented on 6.8.2016, the bail order qua the petitioner has been cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds have been forfeited by the trial Court.

A vague plea has been put forth that on account wrong date having been noticed, the petitioner could not appear on 6.8.2016 and also on subsequent dates.

The petitioner is accused of having been found in possession of non-commercial quantity of heroin.

Without entering into the controversy regarding the reasonableness of the accused for non-appearance, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition in limine in the interest of expeditious disposal of trial.

Notice to the Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, notice has been accepted by Ms.H.K.Athwal, DAG., Punjab, present in the Court. Copy given.

The petition is disposed of in limine with a direction that the petitioner will put in appearance before the trial Court on or before 1.10.2016. In case of petitioner doing so, he shall be released on bail on his furnishing fresh bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of said Court. In case of non-compliance of the order on the part of petitioner, this petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.
