INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.87 dated 05.02.2015, registered at Police Station City Sonapat, under Sections 302 and 449 IPC read with Section 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case. Learned State counsel appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the present petitioner is close friend of main accused, Ashok, who is step-son of deceased-Kamlesh. Kamlesh was found lying on the roof with injuries. She

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was taken to the hospital and was declared dead.

Learned State counsel argued that CCTV footage is also there to support the prosecution version showing the present petitioner coming out from the house along with accused-Ashok.

Keeping in view the fact and circumstances of the case and nature and gravity of the offence and without discussing the facts in minute details, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.

However, as the petitioner has been in custody since 06.02.2015, therefore, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial by giving short adjournments or by adjourning the case on day to day basis, if requires. Concerned Investigating Officer/Station House Officer is also directed to produce all the remaining prosecution witnesses for examination before learned trial Court at the earliest i.e. on next two-three dates.
