This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to ensure the life and liberty of the petitioner; to register a FIR against the accused for committing fraud and cheating with the petitioner and arrest them; and to recover the Fortuner car of the petitioner from the accused person.

The learned counsel states that at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, UT Chandigarh to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Aashima Mor, Addl. P.P., UT Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. A complete set of paperbook has been handed over to her in the Court.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advert to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to decide and consider the representation, Annexure P-2, by passing a speaking order, expeditiously, preferably within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
