The petitioner is seeking directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and also take appropriate action against respondent Nos. 5 to 7 for threatening her as well as causing financial loss to her. The petitioner filed a complaint under Section 498-A, 406 IPC against respondent No.5 and her other family members. They were summoned vide order dated 18.07.2013. Thereafter, she filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and she was granted interim maintenance of Rs.1500/- vide order dated 25.05.2015 (Annexure P-1). Thereafter, she was being harassed by respondent No.5 and reported the matter to respondent No.3-SSP, District Tarn Taran vide representation dated 19.06.2015 (Annexure P-2) and a similar application dated 01.08.2015 (Annexure P-3)

On notice, the status report has been filed by way of affidavit by DSP Sub Division Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 stating that the averments made in the petition were found to be frivolous and without any truth. The matter was enquired and as per report of SHO & DSP dated 11.01.2016 and 12.01.2016 (Annexure R-1 and R-2) it was found false and statements recorded have been attached.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.

The petition stands disposed of.
