Quashing of FIR No. 117 dated 31.08.2014 under Sections 498-A and 494 IPC, registered at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar, is being sought on the basis of compromise dated 24.08.2016 (Annexure P/2).

The FIR was registered on the basis of statement made by Paramjeet Kaur-respondent No.2 alleging that she is married to petitioner-Baljinder Singh, but is residing at her parental house for the last three and a half years and has no child out of this wedlock. Later on, she came to know that her husband in connivance with his family members, without giving her divorce, has re-married to one Baljinder Kaur and a male child has born out of the wedlock. In this background, the FIR was got registered.

However, the matter has now been duly compromised, vide compromise dated 24.08.2016 (Annexure P/2). In compliance of order dated 16.09.2016, report dated 18.11.2016 of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sri Anandpur Sahib, has been received in this regard. As per report, statement of parties have been recorded. Complainant stated that the matter stands compromised between the parties and she does not want to proceed further against the accused and has no objection, if the present F.I.R be quashed against the petitioners. The compromise has been entered voluntarily. To the same effect is the statements given by petitioners.

Consequently, in view of the status report dated 17.11.2016 and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Dr. Arvind Barsaul etc. versus State of Madhya Pradesh and another 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 910***, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

FIR No. 117 dated 31.08.2014 under Sections 498-A and 494 IPC, registered at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of.
