The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.32,
dated 23.3.2016, registered under Section 420 of the IPC, at Police
Station City Budhlada, District Mansa.

Allegation is that the petitioner had taken a sum of ₹
37,000/- from the complainant for getting his son recruited in the BSF.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has

now been in custody for four months and ten days; it is a case of

Magisterial trial, and there is no chance of early conclusion of the trial.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from aSI Baldev Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
