By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, Bintu-petitioner has sought regular bail, in case FIR No.393, dated 09.07.2016, under Section 379-B IPC, Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat, during the pendency of trial.

2. Undisputably, the petitioner was arrested in this case on 10.07.2016 and after his custodial interrogation, he was remanded to judicial custody, meaning thereby, his further custodial interrogation was/is no more required. Moreover, the Bullet motorcycle, which is alleged to have been snatched by the petitioner and his cronies has been recovered from his co-accused namely Balvir @ Pappu. Final report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has already been submitted in the Court of Id. Jurisdictional

Magistrate after the conclusion thereof. Disposal of the trial would certainly take sufficient long time, keeping in view the number of witnesses to be examined by the prosecution. Moreover, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

3. Taking into consideration all the aforesaid aspects of this case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, during pendency of trial, at the satisfaction of trial court/Duty Magistrate.
