JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Vikramjeet Singh in case FIR No.249 dated 22.11.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 302, 201, 120-B and 149 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Rajpura City, District Patiala.

Main allegation regarding disappearance and assumed murder of Vikram Kumar @ Honey is against alleged paramour Baljit Kaur (who is mother of the present petitioner) and her new associates Sanjiv Kumar and Vipin Kumar.

It is contended that no suspicion was attributed to the petitioner, however, subsequently a supplementary charge sheet has been

framed on the basis that the petitioner had transferred some amount in the bank account of said Sanjiv Kumar. It is stated that the said transaction alone does not indicate any complicity in the matter.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that even otherwise the role attributed is of a conspiracy and the petitioner has already joined investigation and nothing is to be recovered.

Learned State Counsel assisted by SI Kanwar Pal concedes the fact that petitioner has joined investigation and the challan against him stands presented on 19.03.2016.

Learned Counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the confirmation of anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 18th of September, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
