INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent No. 2 to protect their lives and liberty and to provide adequate security to protect them from respondent Nos. 4 to 6, who are relatives of petitioner No.2. The petitioners, who are present in Court today, state that they have solemnized marriage with their own consent in accordance with law. The private respondents are not accepting the marriage of the petitioners and are extending threats to them. Photographs of marriage (Annexure P-1), marriage certificate (Annexure P-2), copy of matriculation certificate of petitioner No.1 (Annexure P-3) and copy of matriculation certificate of petitioner No.2 (Annexure P-4), have been placed on record.

Without going into the validity of the marriage and without saying anything regarding the age of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the petitioners to contact respondent Nos.2 & 3, who, after their satisfaction that the petitioners are actually facing threat, shall take necessary steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from private respondent Nos.4 to 6, as per law.

However, it is made clear that this order, in no way, will affect any other proceedings pending or to be filed against the petitioners etc., which are to be dealt with independently as per law.
