Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of direction issued by this Court on 18.09.2015, the petitioner has joined investigation and had been released on interim bail. He further submits that the offence under Sections 354-A and 354-D IPC are bailable and only the offence under Section 506 IPC is non-bailable which even is not made out as per the allegations levelled in the FIR as no threat was ever given to the complainant.

Learned State counsel has also not disputed the nature of offences as has been stated by learned counsel for the petitioner. The allegations levelled are matter of trial which can be seen during trial. The custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required, keeping in view the fact that said offences are bailable.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and has been released on interim bail, the interim order dated 18.09.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.

The report of the Sexual Harassment Committee has been produced in Court in sealed cover, which has been opened and is returned to State counsel after its perusal.
