Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of F.I.R No. 122/2016 of 8.5.2016 registered under Sections 498A, 406, 323, 354, 34 and 506 IPC, registered at P.S. Old Faridabad.

Learned State counsel has placed on record affidavit of Hanif Qureshi, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Faridabad explaining that petitioner presented himself before the IO on 30.9.2016, 2.10.2016, 8.11.2016 and 24.11.2016 to join in the investigation but IO had not joined the petitioner in the investigation on one or other pretext. The petitioner joined the investigation on 5.12.2016. IO-Ashok Kumar has been suspended and a regular departmental enquiry has been initiated against the delinquent IO vide order dated 7.12.2016. No recovery is to be effected from him.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 23.9.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to file fresh bail bonds after presentation of the challan.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
