This order shall dispose of Criminal Misc.No.M-32906 of 2016, filed by petitioner Jagdeep Singh alias Mani and Criminal Misc.No.M-33040 of 2016, filed by petitioner Sarabjit Kaur, under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.22 dated 01.03.2016, registered at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana, under Sections 307, 323, 325, 326, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC.

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As regards petitioner Sarabjit Kaur, learned counsel has argued that no injury is attributed to her and she has been in custody since 01.04.2016.

As regards petitioner Jagdeep Singh alias Mani, learned counsel has argued that though the allegation of causing injury are there but the injury caused by him does not attract Section 326 IPC and he has been in custody since March, 2016. Learned counsel for the petitioners further argued that the injured has since been discharged from the hospital and challan has been presented.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has accepted these factual assertions.

Therefore, in these circumstances and without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the custody period, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioners on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petitions stand allowed.

Since the main cases have been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
