The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR
No.30, dated 24.3.2016, registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 506, 34
of the IPC, at Police Station Sadar Abohar.

On the last date, the following contention was noticed:-

“ Learned counsel states that it is a cross version case but since the father of the complainant is Inspector in the police the version of the petitioner was not recorded even though they reached the hospital at 9.30 PM while the complainant's side reached at 10.40 PM.”

Apart from that, counsel for the petitioner has argued that as per the FIR also, the petitioner is alleged to have given the injury on the right side of the chest and there is no injury corresponding thereto in the MLR.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from HC Atma Ram, has accepted the fact that the petitioner side has also received injuries and the injury mentioned in the FIR has not been reflected in the MLR.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
