This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No.273 dated 09.07.2016, under Sections 363, 366, 376, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station, Gannaur, District Sonapat.

Learned State counsel has informed that the marriage certificate with regard to the marriage of the prosecutrix with the petitioner was genuine. The prosecutrix has solemnized marriage with the petitioner on 26.05.2016. At that time, she was 19 years of age. The present FIR has been got registered by the prosecutrix herself by alleging that the petitioner had kidnapped her. After investigation, challan has been presented on 06.10.2016 and the trial is fixed on 20.10.2016 for framing of charges. There are 15 prosecution witnesses to be examined.

Keeping in view that the prosecutrix was major at the time of marriage and the fact that after verification, the marriage certificate has been

found to be genuine, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat.
