The petitioner is alleged to have received a sum of Rs.15 lacs from Dilbagh Singh in order to get his brother Jasbir Singh released on bail and getting Jagdeep Kaur declared as innocent.

Statement of Dilbagh Singh in Court on oath has already been recorded on April 2, 2016. He has not supported the case of prosecution . The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. August 22, 2015. Co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Lakhwinder Singh has already been granted the concession of bail. On the principle of parity, petitioner in said circumstances can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
