This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents N. 3 to 8.

The facts of the case are that petitioner No.1 was going to Sector 38, Chandigarh on his car when some body hit it with a stick near Dhanas Bridge but he drove his car with speed. However, one tempo waylaid him at the lights of Sector 25, Chandigarh, from which

respondents No. 3 to 8 came out and attacked petitioner No.1 with swords, sticks and desi katta i.e. country made pistol but somehow he managed to escape and saved his life. He then got the present FIR registered against the aforesaid private respondents who are all anti social elements. Thereafter on 18.08.2016 it was 'Raksha Bandhan' and petitioner No.1 was present at his sister's house i.e. petitioner No.2 at Dhanas and all the aforesaid persons passed through the street on motor cycles. At that time petitioner No.2, his brother, was present at a *Bidi* stall. They stopped their motor cycles and exhorted that they would finish all of them for getting the FIR registered.

Learned counsel states that various complaints/representations have been submitted by the petitioners in this regard to respondents No.1 and 2. The private respondents have made their lives a hell. After the filing of complaints, the aforesaid private respondents usually stand in front of their house holding sticks etc. in their hands in order to threaten them. Despite making complaints to the official respondents, no action has been taken thereon as yet. He further states that at this stage the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No. 1 to look into their complaint/representation Annexures P-14 and take whatever action he deems necessary thereon.

I find this to be a fair request.

In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No1 to look into the complaint/representation Annexure P-14 and take whatever action he deems necessary thereon within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified cpy of this order.
