On appreciation of preliminary evidence in a criminal complaint filed by the petitioner, Chief Judicial Magistrate, Fatehabad declined to issue summons against Mukesh Kumar respondent No. 1, however, other persons had been summoned. Revision petition filed by the petitioner against the non-summoning of Mukesh Kumar has been dismissed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehabad.

I have gone through the facts and circumstances of the case. The accused No. 16 was Mukesh Kumar, SHO of the Police Station Sadar, Fatehabad, mentioned in the complaint. The preliminary evidence produced does not indicate that he in his official capacity had at any stage connived with the other accused or that he was a member of unlawful assembly. No ground is made out to interfere in the orders passed by the Courts below.
