Heard learned counsel for the rival parties and perused the interim order dated 19.09.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

In FIR No.88 dated 12.06.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Sections 325, 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar, Ambala, petitioners were granted ad-interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 19.09.2016 by this Court.

Petitioners in the present petition are said to have merely given fist blows along with Kulbir Singh (petitioner in CRM-M-32790 of 2016) who had used sword as a weapon.

In that view of the matter, interim order dated 19.09.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the present petitioners, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
