This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.98 dated 24.08.2016 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 34 IPC, at Police Station Bhikhi District Mansa.

On 19.09.2016, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel states that apart from the merits of the case the petitioner and the complainant have arrived at a compromise.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Thind, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. Mr. B.S. Jatana, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply a copy

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of the petition to the learned opposite counsel during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 26.9.2016. .”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Darshan Singh, accepts that the compromise has been effected between the parties.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Ordered accordingly.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer on 07.10.2016 and on any other date as and when his presence is required. In case, the petitioner does not appear before the investigating officer in the aforesaid manner, the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
