Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty and to provide adequate security to protect them from respondent Nos.4 to 8, who are parents and brothers of petitioner No.1. The petitioners, who are present in Court today, further contend that they being major have solemnized marriage with their own consent in accordance with law. The private respondents are not accepting the marriage of the petitioners and are extending threats to them. Copies of matriculation certificate of petitioner No.1 (Annexure P-1), matriculation certificate of petitioner No.2, marriage certificate of petitioners (Annexure P-3) and affidavit of petitioner No.1 (Annexure P-5) and marriage photographs of petitioners (Annexure P-4), have been placed on record.

Without going into the validity of conversion of religion by petitioner No.1 and validity of marriage, the present petition is disposed

of with the directions to the petitioners to contact respondents No.2 and 3, who, after their satisfaction that the petitioners are actually facing threat, shall take necessary steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from private respondent Nos.4 to 8, as per law. The direction has been issued only for the limited purpose of protecting the life and liberty of the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order, in no way, will affect any other proceedings pending or to be filed against the petitioners etc., which are to be dealt with independently as per law.
