JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought transfer of investigation pertaining to FIR No. 169, dated 26.07.2016, under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Police Station Israna, District Panipat from the officials respondents No. 4 to State Crime Branch Haryana for conducting fair and impartial investigation.

At the very outset of the arguments, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Subhash Chand, Police Station Israna, District Panipat has submitted that on conclusion of investigation, report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C. has already been presented before the Jurisdictional Magistrate and now, the trial court is seisin of the matter.
