This petition has been filed for directions to respondent No.3 and local police not to harass the petitioner and his family members.

On 17.09.2014 the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel seeks an adjournment to file a specific affidavit with regard to the averment made in paragraph No.4 of the petition to the effect that the grandmother of the petitioner transferred the house to him.

Adjourned sine die.

To be listed as and when an application is moved in this regard.”

Since no affidavit was filed the notice was issued to the learned counsel for the petitioner for 05.08.2016 but none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner on that date and the matter was adjourned for 16.08.2016. On 16.08.2016 none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner and the matter was adjourned for 19.09.2016. Even today none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed in default.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
