The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 for taking appropriate action against respondent Nos.4 to 11 for registration of case under Sections 406/498A/120-B IPC for misappropriation of dowry articles and for causing cruelty to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to the complaint (Annexure P-1) made by the petitioner to the respondent No.2 with regard to the harassment made by her husband and his family members for demand of dowry. The marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with Lakhwinder Kumar on 20.06.2014 and one child was born out of this wedlock. Her grievance is that despite repeated visits and reminders, the police authorities have not taken any action against the private respondents.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of by giving

directions to Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot-respondent No.2

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to look into the matter and decide the representation (Annexure P-1)
expeditiously, in accordance with law.
