Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered on the basis of secret information alleging that the petitioner along with two others used to indulge in selling the intoxicating powder at the shop of one more co-accused Paramjit Singh and when the raid was conducted at the shop of Paramjit Singh, the petitioner along with three other co-accused managed to escape.

Recovery of poppy husk, 1400 intoxicating tablets and 28 grams of heroin was effected in the absence of the petitioner from the shop of Paramjit Singh.

It will certainly be a debatable issue whether the petitioner could be said to be in actual physical possession of 2 kg of poppy husk and 1400 intoxicating tablets containing diphenoxylate hydrochloride. Petitioner is not involved in any other case.

In view of said circumstances, the petition is allowed.
Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail
bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
