Petitioners are the wives of Mukesh Kumar and Mohit Kumar who allegedly indulged in export business. A complaint under Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C. had been filed against them alleging that they in connivance with the present petitioners have duped the complainant by withholding the promised sale consideration of the articles sold by the complainant.

So far as Mukesh Kumar and Mohit Kumar are concerned, their application for pre-arrest bail has been dismissed on account of their conduct by a separate order passed by this Court.

So far as the petitioners are concerned, they claim to be sleeping participants in the business transactions of their husbands. The culpability of the petitioners would certainly be a debatable issue despite the fact that they are signatory of the cheque which had earlier been issued on behalf of the complainant company M/s Viva D Mohit International, Gurgaon.

The petitioners pursuant to the interim orders have already joined investigation.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of the petitioners, they will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that they will join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or hamper investigation, in any manner.
