Learned State counsel upon instructions from S.I. Satbir Singh would apprise the Court that the present petitioner namely Sanjeev Kumar has forwarded a communication to the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Hisar seeking transfer of jail from Rohtak to Central Jail, Hisar by stating that he has undergone treatment for brain tumor at P.G.I.M.E.R, Rohtak and now his condition is stable and since he is required to visit P.G.I.M.E.R, Rohtak only once a month, accordingly, he may be transferred from Rohtak Jail to Central Jail, Hisar.

In the light of such categoric stand and submission made by learned State counsel, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner states that he would not press the instant petition filed under section 439 Cr.P.C read with section 482 Cr.P.C for release of the petitioner on interim bail.
