The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.112 dated 11.08.2016, registered under Sections 420, 177, 181, 199, 200, 465, 467, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City, Distt. Hoshiarpur.

Heard.

On 19.09.2016, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel contends that the petitioner is illiterate household lady and has no concern with Pritam Singh, allegedly to whom the petitioner has been projected as surety. In fact the petitioner had only identified her son. She is not involved in any other FIR.

Notice of motion for 16.11.2016.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, she shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

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I attest to the accuracy and
authenticity of this document
Chandigarh

- 1. That she shall make herself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2. That she shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;*
- 3. That she shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”*

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 19.09.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
