This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the order dated 03.11.2015 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned JMIC, Ludhiana in complaint case No.40 dated 26.02.2014, vide which respondent has been granted ad interim maintenance and judgment dated 25.07.2016 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Court of learned Addl. D&SJ, Ludhiana bearing criminal appeal No.141 dated 06.01.2016, vide which appeal under Section 29 of Protection of Women From Domestic Violence Act against the order passed by the Court of learned JMIC (Annexure P-5) has been dismissed.

Learned JMIC, Ludhiana, vide his order dated 22.12.2015 granted interim maintenance to the tune of Rs.2500/- and Rs.1500/- as litigation expenses to the respondent. It is alleged by the respondent that petitioner was drawing pension of Rs.25,000/- per months, and earning Rs.50,000/- per month from hosiery business. As such, total income of the petitioner was Rs.75,000/- per months. After going through the arguments of learned counsel for the both the parties, learned trial Court granted interim

maintenance to the tune of Rs.2500/- per month and litigation expenses to the tune of Rs.1500/- which was also upheld by the learned Addl.District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana.

In view of the above, the orders of both the learned Courts below do not reflect any material illegality, irregularity or perversity which warrant any interference. As such, the present petition is also dismissed as such.
