By filing the present petitions under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners seek regular bail in case FIR No.32 dated 05.02.2015, registered under Sections 18, 21, 27 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station GRP Ludhiana.

Contents that the petitioners are not named in the FIR. They have been implicated in the instant FIR on the disclosure statement of co-accused Ashok Kumar. No recovery has been effected from them. Co-accused Manpreet Singh and Karan Singh @ Kalu have already been released on bail by this Court.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that out of 26 prosecutions witnesses, 03 have already been examined.

Heard.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioners are not named in the FIR, they are not involved in any other case and only 03 out of 26 prosecution witnesses have been examined so far, therefore, it can safely be inferred that the conclusion of the trial may take considerable time, without advertng to the merits of the instant case, the present petitions are allowed. The petitioners be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
