Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents 1 to 4 to take legal action against respondents No. 5 and 6 and others and to record statements of the petitioners and to conduct fair and impartial investigation. With further prayer to arrest the accused persons as well as to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners.

2. Notice of motion to respondents-State only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala to inquire

into the allegations unfolded in the representation dated 16.08.2016 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala-respondent No.2, to inquire into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representation dated 16.08.2016 (Annexure P-1) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
