INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner, Gurpreet Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.83 dated 14.07.2016, registered at Police Station Khamanon, District Fatehgarh Sahib, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is now not required for custodial interrogation. The matter is stated to be compromised between the petitioner and complainant and

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copy of compromise (Annexure P-5) has also been placed on record.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the fact that matter has been compromised, I find that no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in this petition, the same is allowed. The order dated 19.09.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
