By this petition the petitioner has sought directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to ensure safety and security of the petitioner and her family members at the instance of respondents No.4 to 7 and not to call her to police station time and again in violation of the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this

connection the petitioner has also moved a representation dated 27.07.2016 (Annexure P-3) and at this stage she would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate action on her representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2-the SSP, Patiala is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
